Lonestar Strip Magic- *3 hour class / Skilled beginner or intermediate level*

Most people don't think of Jelly Roll strips and Lonestar blocks as being very compatible but the truth is, they were practically made for each other! Using the **EZ Jelly Roll Ruler** and 2½" strips (either from a pre-cut bundle or your own stash of fabrics) Kimberly will teach you to quickly and expertly strip-piece and cut diamonds and assemble a traditional-looking Lonestar block. **The magic with her method is there are no "Y" or set-in seams!** Sound impossible? Not with Kimberly's new technique and precision-pieced method! Simply choose 3 fabrics for the star and checkerboarder plus 1 background fabric and you'll be finished with a stunning block!!!

Supplies Needed (Note: Kimberly will have some of her EZ Jelly Roll Rulers available for a special discount to guild members or a few to lend in class for students to try.)

- Fabric as outlined in Fabric Requirements chart below and Neutral sewing thread
- 45 mm (or larger) rotary cutter and rotary mat
- Ruler: 6" x 24" OR 4" x 18" and 10½" (or larger) square ruler (optional, but very helpful for squaring up blocks)
- Basic Sewing Supplies such as scissors, straight pins, general sewing supplies, seam ripper
- Bring anything you might need to make your classroom experience more efficient, stress-free, and enjoyable! (Think: extra light, extension cord, a cushion to sit on, magnifying or reading glasses, something to drink in a cup with a spill proof lid, chocolate... and most importantly, a sense of fun!)

Fabric Requirements – Bring all fabric except batting and backing with you to class. You may bring 1 – Jelly Roll bundle to class plus ½ yard of background fabric OR you may bring yardage as outlined below:

FABRIC	YARDS	CUTTING
#1 – Center of star and checker border	1/3 yd	• Cut 4 – 2½" strips
#2 – Radiant (middle) of star	¼ yd	• Cut 2 – 2½" strips
#3 – Outer star points and binding	1/3 yd	• Cut 4 – 2½" strips
#4 – Background fabric	½ yd	• Cut 1 – 6 5/8" strip; subcut 4 – 6 5/8" squares and cut each square 1x diagonally to yield 8 triangles • Cut 1 – 5" strip; subcut 4 – 5" squares and cut each square 1x diagonally to yield 8 triangles
#5 – Checker border	¼ yd	• Cut 3 – 2½" strips
Backing	1 yd	• 36" x 36"
Batting		• 36" x 36"
